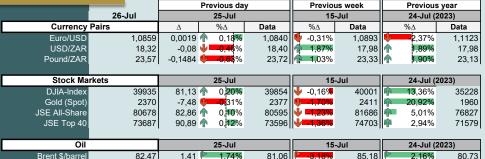

Market Commentary

The Rand traded slightly stronger against the dollar since Thursday. The Rand gained a bit of ground and opened at R18,32/\$ this morning.

Other FOREX currencies opened this morning at R19,90/€ (- 0,12%) and \$153,58/¥ (- 0,25%). The JSE Resource 10 traded at 59 545 (- 2,51%); the JSE Industrial 25 traded at 107 996 (+ 0,28%) and the JSE Financial 15 traded at 19 367 (+ 1,51%).

Brent crude oil price per barrel climbed by \$1,74/barreld since Thursday and is currently trading at \$82,47/barrel.

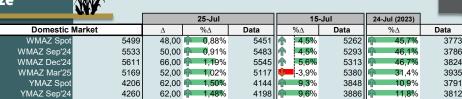

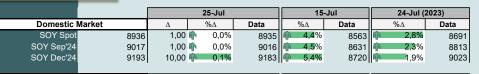

Maize Market commentary

The CBOT maize contract price for the nearest trading month climbed by 0,59% since Thursday. Local: Maize contracts traded with generally upward trends on Thursday. On Thursday afternoon the South African Grain Information Service (SAGIS) released the latest trade report. For white maize a total of 30 750 tons was exported to the follwing destinations: 63% to Zimbabwe (52% this season); 19% to Namibia (14%); 8% to Lesotho (8%); 7% to Botswana (17%); 2% to Mozambique (7%) and 1% to Eswatini (3%). Cumulative exports for the season is 313 246 tons. For yellow maize a total of 15 397 tons was exported, mostly to: 54% to Zimbabwe (53% of the season); 13% to Botswana (14% this season); 12% to Mozambique (10%); 9% to Eswatini (12%); 9% to Namibia (8%) and 4% to Saudi Arabia (1%). The cumulative total for the season is 167 011 tons.

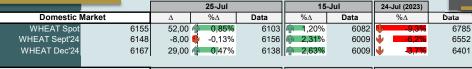

Soybean Market Commentary

The CBOT soybean contract price for the nearest contract month climbed very slightly by 0,45% since Thursday.

Local: South African soybean contracts traded with unchanged trends on Thursday. The latest export data indicates that 53 788 tons of whole soybeans have been exported until June. Shipments have mostly been to Vietnam and Zimbabwe. There have also been small amounts of imports from Eswatini (214 tons) and Zambia (137 tons).

Wheat Market Commentary

The CBOT wheat contract price for the nearest trading month fell by 1,72% this morning.

Local: The local wheat contracts closed with upward trends for most of the contracts on Thursday. On Thursday afternoon the South African Grain Information Service (SAGIS) released the latest trade report. For the week ending 19 July, a total of 107 331 ton of wheat was imported: 67% from Russia; 24% from Lithuania and 9% from Poland. For this season a total of 1 563 954 tons of wheat have been imported: 27% from Russia, 23% from Poland, 22% from Lithuania; 15% Australia; 8% from Latvia and 2% from the US as well as Estonia.
